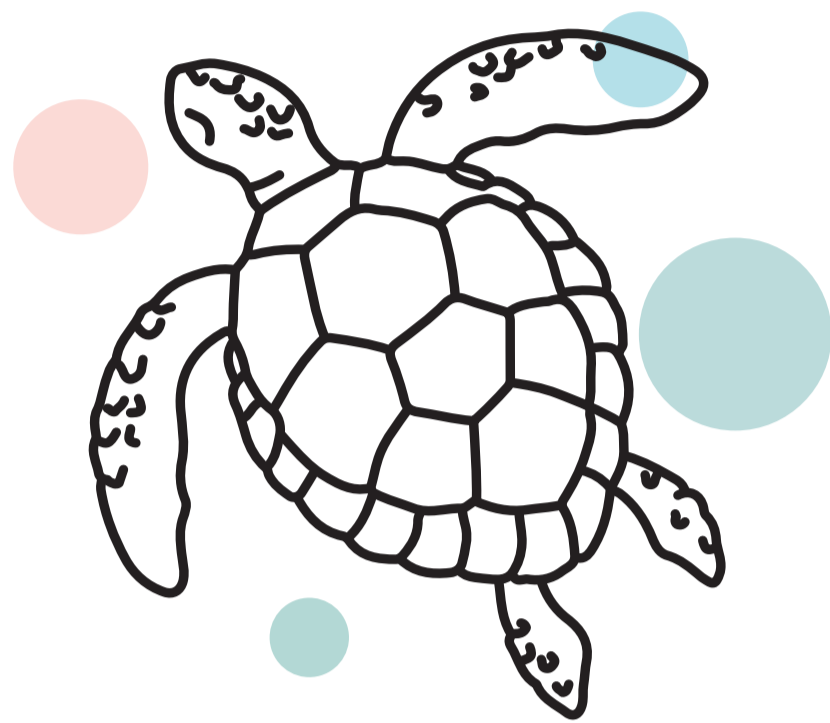


Illegal Souvenirs

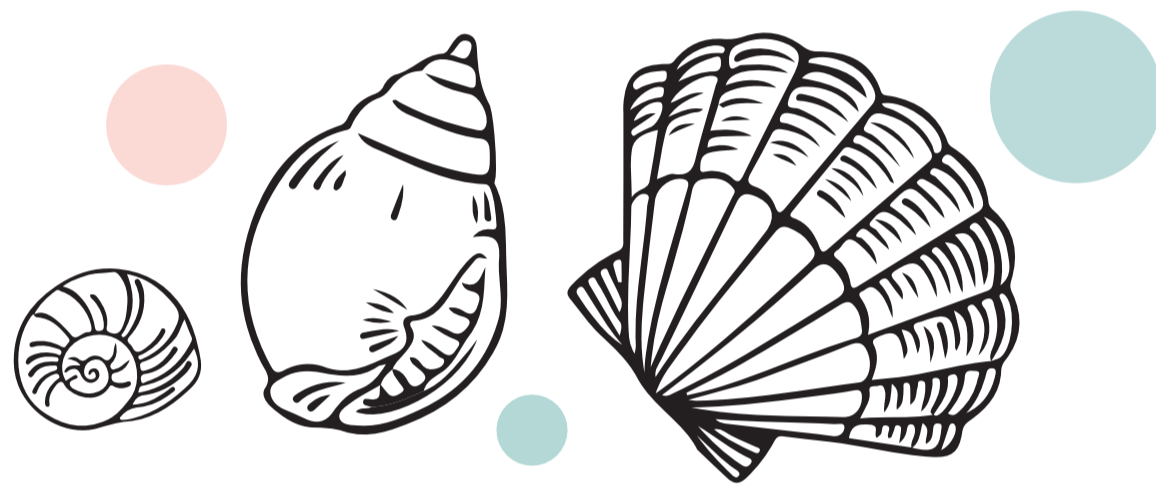
Dear traveler, we know how important it is to take a small souvenir of your trip to Costa Rica, however we urge you not to buy or extract any of the following items or species, since it is a crime according to the Criminal Law of Costa Rica.



Animals: It is illegal to buy souvenirs that are made from animals, such as for example:

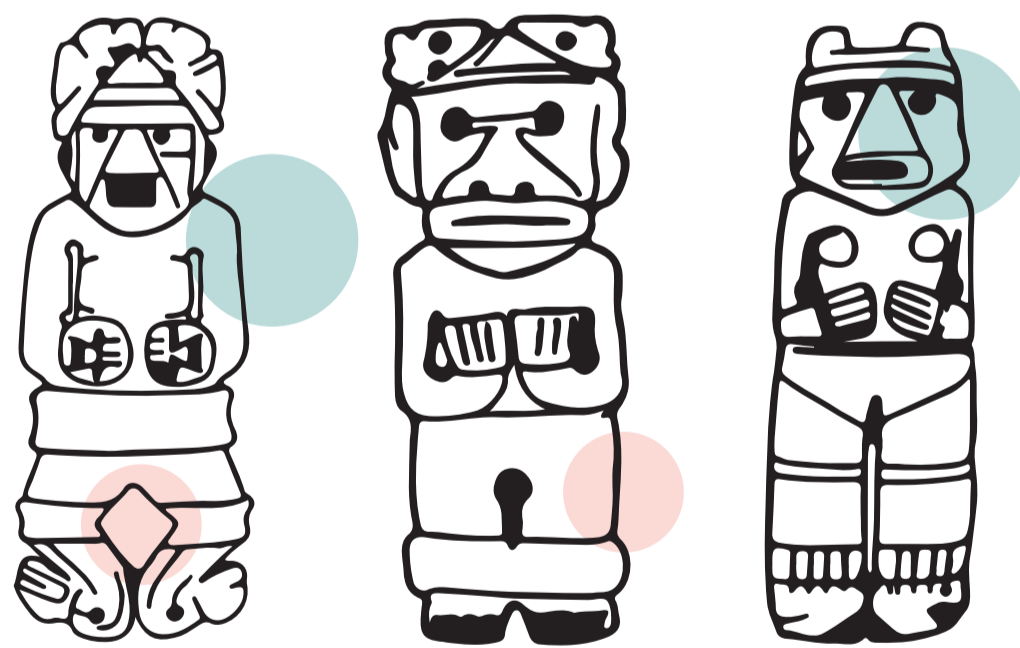
- ↳ Carey Turtle.
- ↳ Bird feathers.
- ↳ Cocodrile skin.
- ↳ Wild animal skins.

Shells and Stones: However beautiful the shells and stones may be, they should not be removed from their ecosystems, since they fulfill a very important role in the ecosystem.



Seeds, flora and plants: It is strictly prohibited to extract any species of plant, flower, fruit or seed from protected areas according to the Wildlife Law, which has a penalty of up to 5 years in prison.

Historical or archaeological pieces: The extraction, purchase, or sale of any material object that has a genuine historical, cultural, or archaeological value in Costa Rica is prohibited, which is punishable by up to 10 years in prison.



Wildlife species cannot be collected, consumed, displayed, sold, or traded except as part of a regulated activity that ensures their use is sustainable and complies with local, national, and international laws. Bella Aventura, the supplier, does not promote souvenirs or food containing endangered species of flora and fauna, as stated in the CITES treaty and the IUCN 'Red List'. If Bella Aventura is found to be involved in any activities that violate Costa Rican Wildlife and Heritage regulations, the contract can be terminated without prior notice.
